

## **LIST OF REQUIREMENTS BY BETH DIN**

- (a) Copy of Bride's parents Ketubah;
- (b) Copy of Groom's parents Ketubah;
- (c) Copy of Bride's ID documents (front page) and copy of **FULL** Birth Certificate;
- (d) Copy of Groom's ID documents (front page) and copy of **FULL** Birth Certificate;
- (e) Three black & white ID photos each of Bride and Groom;
- (f) Affidavit from Bride stating she is Jewish, single and never married (refer Clause G & H);
- (g) Affidavit from Groom stating he is Jewish, single and never married (refer Clause G & H);
- (h) If either the Bride or Groom is divorced, the Affidavit must state he/she has been married and since the divorce has not remarried. A copy of the Get and front page of civil divorce must be attached;
- (i) If either the Bride or the Groom is widowed, the Affidavit must state that since the death, he/she has not remarried. A copy of the Death Certificate must be enclosed;
- (j) If converted, the conversion papers must be enclosed.
- (k) If either the Bride or Groom were not born in South Africa, a letter from their local Beth Din confirming they are Jewish by birth and eligible to be married in an Orthodox Shul, must accompany this application.
- (l) If either the Bride or Groom are not South African, a copy of their Permit Number on entering South Africa must be submitted to our office.
- (m) Copy of ID documents (front page) of the two witnesses (South African) who will sign the Marriage Register (civil papers) and their telephone numbers.

**N.B. All Affidavits of marital status must be signed and stamped by a Commissioner of Oaths.**
